The Education project is linked to the Forestry project, as we are encouraging schools to get involved with a re planting project whereby every child attending school plants a tree sapling for each of the 3 terms. When the trees are big enough they can be cut down and sold for money or used for timber or fuel and this money can be put back into buying more saplings. If this project works, it will provide sustainable income for the future

The Marine project is linked with the Education and Community project, as there is huge importance in helping the local people understand the importance of protecting the coastline and species that live in the seas around Shimoni and that in protecting the species they are protecting their livelihoods in terms of their heritage as well as the tourism industry

Forestry

The Forestry and Marine Projects are linked because when trees are removed and cut down from an area, any rain or wind will cause the loose soil from the open ground to be washed into the sea. This soil runoff has a devastating effect on the coral as it forms a layer of silt covering the coral and preventing it from getting the sunlight it needs in order to photosynthesize and therefore live.
